Overview of Proposed Pilot for 2008-09 School Year

- Piloted at Grades 4 & 7
- Two content specific writing tasks/assignments (formative)
- Two on-demand writing tasks/assignments (one benchmark, one summative)
- Grade 4 Paper-pencil based system
- Grade 7 Centrally housed, electronic statewide system

Scaled Vision for Writing

- Students grades K-12 writing across content and on demand
- Students in grades 6-12 using technology tools to complete writing assignments/tasks (elementary optional dependent on developmental level of student)
- Students in grades 6-12 posting work in electronic portfolio
- Students in grades K-12 composing four content-based assignments/tasks and two on-demand pieces
- ■Teachers in grades 6-12 using electronic system for student feedback, scoring, and professional development
- DPI using electronic system for auditing and for building teacher capacity

"Traditional"	Proposed "New"
Assessment of Writing	Assessment of Writing
Only paper/pencil administrations	Grade 7 electronic-based (16 LEAs)
One score for accountability purposes	Multiple scores for assessment and instructional feedback (remote auditing)
Writing instruction delivered in preparation for a single-day test	Year-long writing instruction (implementing the writing process) delivered across all content areas for different types of writing tasks/assignments
