

NJROTC EXPANSION


- Approval for expansion of the NJROTC program from 613 to 626 units has been granted by the Secretary of the Navy
- Expansion is based on the view that JROTC is a "viable alternative to reach young, at-risk, men and women at an early age and instill in them the strengths and ideals required for a successful future"






