

## Promising Results for Learn and Earn Early College High Schools

#### 2007 EOC Results

- 39% had performance composites of 80 or better (almost 5x the percentage statewide)
- 73% had the highest performance composite in their districts
- 52% designated "high growth" compared to 34% of all high schools in the state

9th Grade Promotion, Dropout Rates

- 83% promoted 95% or more of 9<sup>th</sup> graders (compared to 85% state promotion rate)
- All had 9<sup>th</sup> grade dropout rates lower than state
