UNC Charlotte Overview



Fall 2012 Enrollment

- 3,539 New freshmen
- 2,531 New transfer students
- 21,225 Total undergraduates
- 5,049 Total graduate students
- 26, 274 Total students



Diversity in Fall 2011

- 16% African American
- .5% American Indian
- 4.8 % Asian
- 5.8% Hispanic
- 62% Caucasian
- 24% of Undergraduates are 24 years of age and older



Diverse Student Body

- 66% of UNC Charlotte students qualify for financial aid
- 40% qualify for the Pell Grant representing over 8,300 students
- 32% are first generation college students

49er Finish Eligibility Criteria

Undergraduate student

Left campus for one academic year

90 earned credit hours (senior status)

2.0 cumulative grade point average or higher

No financial or disciplinary actions





HISTORY OF THE 49ER FINISH PROGRAM



Spring 2006 Initial Survey of Students

- Mailed survey to 1,232 former senior students
- 133 former students returned surveys and 95 requested follow-up contact
 - 58% Female, 42% Male
 - 56% Ages 25-34
 - 80% Caucasian, 14% African American
 - 47% Married, 45% Single
 - 52% Had at least one child
 - 76% Worked full-time



Withdrawal from UNC Charlotte

- 67% Stated withdrawal was temporary
- 53% Stated definite plans to return to school
- 27% Graduated from another institution
- 4% No longer wished to pursue a degree




Reasons for Leaving

- Difficulty parking










MARKETING THE 49ER FINISH PROGRAM



- Operating as an ombudsman between academic departments and students




49er Finish Program

MEASURING STUDENT AND PROGRAM SUCCESS



Spring 2012 Data

- 95 undergraduates enrolled
- Completed 659 credit hours collectively
- 19 additional students were in graduate school or are fifth-year students at UNC Charlotte

 2012 Malcolm Knowles Award for Outstanding Adult Education Program from the American Association for Adult and Continuing Education






Private Investment

- Osher Reentry Scholarship
 - Fall 2012: UNC Charlotte awarded \$1 million Osher
 Foundation Endowment
 - Since Spring 2009, \$250,000 has been awarded to 94 students
- Douglas Reentry Scholarship
 - In Spring 2012, UNC Charlotte received an endowment of nearly \$400,000
 - Award of \$18,000 to 10 students Fall 2012
