In response to NCGS 115C-12(40), *Increase Access to Career and Technical Education*, the State Board of Education established three **high school diploma endorsements** to encourage students to obtain requisite job skills, to reduce the need for remedial education in institutions of higher education, and to provide a more comprehensive student profile indicating credentials and rigorous pathway of study upon graduating from high school. The State Board of Education established these three high school diploma endorsements in collaboration with UNC General Administration and NC Community College System Office. The three endorsements are: Career, College, and College/UNC. These diploma endorsements encourage career and college readiness and reflect course completion and grades accomplished.

Table 1 is an overview of the number of graduates in 2019-20 who earned the Career, College and College/UNC diploma endorsements. Note that graduates may earn more than one endorsement. Tables 2, 3, and 4 give further detailed information of each diploma endorsement by each Public School Unit (PSU).

Please note that last year was the first year that the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction (NCDPI) implemented the legislative requirement that students shall only receive a high school diploma endorsement when the student achieves at least the benchmark reading score established by a nationally norm-referenced college admissions test. Due to the addition of this requirement, diploma endorsements have significantly lessened for the 2019-20 reporting year.

2020 Graduates Data Summary:

With new ACT/SAT requirement:

- A total of 58,831 high school diploma endorsements were awarded to 2019-20 graduates last year. This is a decrease of 89,136 endorsements (60%) from last year.
- 24% of 2019-20 graduates earned a College endorsement. This is a 35% decrease from last year.
- 24% of 2019-20 graduates earned a College/UNC endorsement. This is a 33% decrease from last year.
- 5% of 2019-20 graduates earned a Career endorsement. This is a 14% decrease

- from last year.
- 4% of 2019-20 graduates earned all three endorsements. This is a 12% decrease from last year.

Without new ACT/SAT requirement:

- A total of 124,512 (53% more) high school diploma endorsements would have been awarded without the ACT/SAT benchmark reading score requirement.
- 52% of College endorsements would have been earned by graduates without the ACT/SAT benchmark reading score requirement. This is a 7% decrease from last year.
- 52% of College/UNC endorsements would have been earned by graduates without the ACT/SAT benchmark reading score requirement. This is a 5% decrease from last year.
- 10% of graduates would have earned a Career endorsement without the ACT/SAT benchmark reading score requirement. This is a 9% decrease from last year.
- 9% of graduates would have earned all three endorsement without the ACT/SAT benchmark reading score requirement. This is a 7% decrease from last year.

Data Analysis:

NCDPI believes that these decreases in attainment of the legislated High School Diploma Endorsements are related to three factors.

- The primary factor is the addition of a benchmark reading score from a nationally norm-referenced college admissions test, either the ACT or SAT, as a predictive criterion for success in college courses. This factor can explain the significant decrease from the previous reporting year and was expected because of the level of ACT scores typically received by NC's public school students. Furthermore, this was exacerbated because there are students who may not have been able to turn in their scores to the LEA to be counted towards an endorsement due to the buildings being closed as a result of the pandemic. Note: LEAs only receive the one ACT score from the NCDPI administered assessment. Students have to bring in other scores if they would like them to be considered for this recognition.
- The second factor is attributed to the closure of school buildings due to COVID-19
 during the Spring semester for all endorsements. Students may have chosen to take a
 PC19 for a certain required course, which would not be factored into the GPA. This
 seems to have related to the 5-9% decrease, without the reading benchmark.
- Additionally, decreases in the Career endorsement can be attributed to decreases in credential attainment due to operational transitions to the NC Career Pathways model as per the 2018 legislation Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act (Perkins V).

The State Board of Education/NC Department of Public Instruction is unable to report on the impact of the high school diploma endorsements because the direct causal relationship of endorsements cannot be determined to high school graduation, college acceptance and remediation, and post-high school employment. While graduation rates have increased and remediation rates have been decreasing with the UNC system colleges and universities, NCDPI is unable to determine the causal relationship of the endorsements on those changes. Note that post-high school employment rates are not able to be determined at this point. Furthermore, NCDPI is unable to accurately determine how many times a student retakes a nationally norm-referenced exam since additional test results must be disclosed by the parent. The above results are primarily based on students' 11th grade ACT reading outcomes which NCDPI administers as part of its testing and accountability program.
