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Students with Disabilities – Definition of Residence

Each year on December 1 and April 1, each child involved in Exceptional Children services in North Carolina is counted in a bi-annual census. The data is gathered electronically through ECATS (Every Child Accountability System), the Exceptional Children data system. This count includes students with disabilities in public school, public charter schools, residential schools for the deaf and blind, the Division of Prison, Dept. of Health and Human Services and NC Division of Juvenile Justice.

The report being reviewed is the December 1 child count. The December child count is used to determine the amount of Federal money the state receives based on the following formula.

Each LEA will receive 75% of their allocation calculated using the December 1998 head count. This establishes their base. The remaining funds will be distributed as follows: 85% will be allocated based on Average Daily Membership (ADM) including the number of children who are enrolled in public and private elementary and secondary schools and 15% will be allocated based on the number of children living in poverty (free and reduced lunch).
