# **Legislative Directive**

Session Law 2019-222, Part III Section 7.19, directed the Superintendent of Public Instruction to establish the School Safety Grants program with the purpose of improving safety in public school units by providing grants for services for students in crisis, school safety training, and safety equipment in schools.

Specific allocations for the 2021-22 school year include:

- \$18 million for School Resource Officers
- \$350,000 for Services for Students in Crisis
- \$350,000 for School Safety Training
- \$8.9 million for Safety Equipment in Schools

This report will serve as the required reporting by Superintendent of Public Instruction to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee, the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Health and Human Services, the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Justice and Public Safety, the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations, and the Fiscal Research Division as indicated in SECTION 7.19 (j) of Session Law 2019-222.

- Identity of each entity that received a grant through the Program
- Amount of funding provided to each entity that received a grant
- Use of funds by each entity that received a grant
- Recommendations for the implementation of additional effective school safety measures. (2019-222, s. 7.19 (j).

#### **Grant Details**

For 2021, the School Safety Grant Program made available \$9.6 million to public schools for services for students in crisis, school safety training, and safety equipment in schools. These funds were available to district, charter, and other independent public schools.

Eighty (80) entities (Public School Units and individual schools) were awarded \$9.6 million. (Appendix A).

# **Anticipated Future Needs**

In 2021, available school safety grant funds totaled \$27 million. NCDPI awarded \$25 million; the difference was due to cap limitations on individual grant programs. Requested funds in the applications received, however, exceeded available funding. The 2021 awards included funding for SROs as well as staff training, safety equipment, students-in-crisis services, and school mental health support personnel.

The 2021 school safety grant funds were limited to \$27 million, and \$18 million (67%) was restricted to the hiring and training of SROs. Considering this, and that the requested amount by PSUs in their 2021 applications exceeded the \$27 million provided at that time, there is a demonstrated interest by PSUs for additional funding for school safety initiatives to include the hiring SROs as well as for staff training, safety equipment, students-in-crisis services, and school mental health support personnel.

#### Recommendations

The following changes would help improve the effectiveness of the school safety grant program advance to goal of strengthening school safety across the state:

- 1. In addition to recurring funding for SRO's, the creation of recurring funding for staff training, safety equipment, and students-in crisis-services.
- 2. Permit carryforward of encumbered, unexpended funds for 60 days. This allows public school units to finish critical trainings over the summer, extend student-in-crisis services during the summer months, and complete procurement processes. This is particularly critical due to the ongoing challenges and disruptions caused by COVID-19.
- 3. Amend the match requirements for SRO funding for lower wealth districts or authorize the use of in-kind match.
