## Headcount of Limited English Proficient Student in North Carolina Public Schools as of October 1, 2002

In accordance with SB 1005, Section 28.9, the Department of Public Instruction is required to prepare a headcount of all limited English proficient students by December 1 of each year.

The current enrollment of those students identified and assessed as limited English proficient in accordance with state regulations as of October 1, 2002, is 60,149. The accompanying table lists the numbers of students by LEA and charter school. Superintendents and directors of charter schools reported the data electronically as part of the annual survey of limited English proficient students.
