SL 2003-284 Section 7.15(b) House Bill 397

Headcount of Limited English Proficient Students in North Carolina Public Schools as of October 1, 2005

In accordance with SL 2003-284, Section 7.15(b), the Department of Public Instruction is required to prepare a headcount of all limited English proficient students and report it by December 1 of each year.

The current enrollment of those students identified and assessed as limited English proficient in accordance with the policies of the State Board of Education (SBE) as of October 1, 2005, is 83,616. These students were identified using the IDEA Proficiency Test and the approved state cut scores. This number represents an increase of 5,221 students, as reported by all LEAs and 19 charter schools. For the second year, every LEA has reported limited English proficient students in their schools.

The accompanying table lists the numbers of students by LEA and charter school. Superintendents and directors of charter schools reported the data electronically as part of the annual survey of limited English proficient students.
