The Higher Education Facilities Financing Act bond program has entered into its seventh year and the constructed facilities are providing significant benefits to the students of the University of North Carolina and to the State. While providing an estimated 88,000 jobs, the program is ensuring that high quality resources, particularly in science and technology facilities, are available to students and researchers as North Carolina transitions from a manufacturing-based economy to one that is more knowledge-based and able to compete in the global environment.

Over the last year, the campuses have made considerable progress.

- 318 of the 319 authorized bond projects are now either in construction (32) or completed (286). A scope change approved by the legislature in July 2008 added one new project to the program at UNC-Chapel Hill. That project is now under design and should be completed by December 2008.
- As of June 30, 2008, \$2.41 billion or 96% of bond program dollars have been expended. The remaining funds are committed to design or construction contracts or held in reserve for land acquisition.
- As part of its continuing commitment to contribute resources to its capital needs, the University has requested and the General Assembly has approved, over \$3.4 billion in projects from nonappropriated sources since 2000.
- The program continues to exceed State goals recommended for Historically Underutilized Businesses (HUBs) by more than 64%.
- UNC projects completed using the Construction Manager (CM) at Risk construction delivery method have significantly out-performed other construction contracting methods in providing contracts to HUBs.
- The State Treasurer has sold all \$2.5 billion of bonds that support the 2000 Higher Education Bond Program.

- With the exception of one project at NC A&T State, the overall program continues at a pace that will result in completion of all projects earlier than anticipated. It is projected that construction for all projects will be completed by October 2009, three months later than was indicated on the baseline schedule adopted by the University and accepted by the Higher Education Bond Oversight Committee in April 2002.
- Appalachian State University, The University of North Carolina at Asheville, The University of North Carolina at Charlotte, North Carolina School of Science and Mathematics, and the North Carolina Arboretum have all achieved the significant milestone of having all their projects complete. The remaining campuses have all of their projects under construction or complete.

As required by the Act, the Board of Governors reports annually on the authorized bond program to the General Assembly.

Attachment 1 of this report provides a summary of the contractual commitments from bond funds by project phase for the program at each campus.

Attachment 2 provides the following information on the bond program:

- 1. the amount of each project funded from the bonds (column  $\underline{5}$ ),
- 2. the total cost of each project (column  $\underline{7}$ ),
- 3. the expenditures to date by project from the bonds (column 8),
- 4. the expenditures to date by project from other sources (column 9), and
- 5. the percentage of each project completed (column 11).

Attachment 3 provides the following information on the bond program:

- 1. the anticipated dates for occupancy for each of these projects (column 6).
- 2. the estimated [20-year, average] operating costs for each project begun in the preceding fiscal year (column 8),
- 3. the proposed source of funds for these operating costs (column 9), and

In addition to providing information on the bond program, the act requires the Board of Governors to report annually on the University's current condition, its presently funded maintenance projects, and its funding needs that would allow the University to be proper stewards of these valuable State assets.

Attachment 4 provides information on the condition of the University's capital assets. Every three years, the State Construction Office reviews the facilities at each UNC constituent institution, documents deficiencies, and estimates the cost to remedy the deficiencies. Their work results in a Facilities Condition and Assessment Program (FCAP) report for each campus. Attachment 4 summarizes these reports by campus. This year, the North Carolina School of Science and Math is included on the list as a constituent institution.

As of the 2007 cycle (the most recent available), the University has a documented backlog of repair needs of \$1.8 billion, of which approximately \$1.3 billion relate to deficiencies in state-supported facilities (column 4) and approximately \$500 million relate to deficiencies in non-state supported facilities (column 7). It is important to note that the FCAP reports do not fully consider the value of non-building infrastructure, which constitutes roughly one-third of the State's physical plant.

Attachments 5 and 6 provide information on the repair, renovation and maintenance projects being undertaken by the University from the 2007 appropriation to the Statewide Reserve for Repairs and Renovation fund.

Attachment 7 provides allocations approved by the Board of Governors to Constituent and Affiliated Institutions from the 2008 appropriation to the Statewide Reserve for Repairs and Renovation fund.

Attachments 8 and 9 provide information on the needs for additional funding to maintain the University's facilities. This information comes from the University's six-year plan for Repairs and Renovation funding, as submitted in the 2007-09 biennial budget request. The total is approximately \$822 million and represents the portion of system-wide repair and renovation needs that institutions propose to fund from the Statewide Reserve for Repairs and Renovation to care for state-supported facilities over the next six years.

With \$73 million remaining to be spent, the campuses are focused on the strong and timely finish of the \$2.5 billion program. Additionally, campuses are addressing new challenges:

- \$1.2 billion in capital improvement projects authorized by the legislature during their 2007 and 2008 sessions;
- The need to integrate sustainability goals into current construction and operation processes to substantially reduce energy and water use and produce buildings that are less expensive to operate over their lifetime.
- Continuing and significant enrollment growth (80,000 students over the next 9 years across the system) that will necessitate getting additional facilities in place sooner, increasing the flexibility in existing facilities to properly handle more and larger classes, and providing new capabilities to support distance and on-line education.
- The need to focus on the maintenance on existing facilities and aging infrastructure with modest Repairs and Renovations funding support.

In summary, the campuses are successfully meeting the challenges of the 2000 Higher Education bond program, appropriately engaging new challenges and remain steadfastly committed to delivering first-rate facilities that will keep North Carolina in the forefront of higher education and well positioned for a promising future.


