This report is generated to comply with the following legislative mandate of SL 2014-50 (SB 815):

The SBE shall notify the Governor and the General Assembly annually by October 1 of the following:

- a) New student data, whether aggregate data, de-identified data, or personally identifiable student data, included or proposed for inclusion in the student data system for the current school year.
- b) Changes to existing data collections for the student data system required for any reason, including changes to federal reporting requirements made by the United States Department of Education.

1. In Response to Career and College Ready requirements per G.S. 115C-12 (40) and State Board policy GCS-L-007:

Advanced Learning and Gifted

- Refined PowerSchool to include the following fields: Endorsement Audit, Endorsement Notes, and Endorsement Override
- Enable documentation of Endorsements for all graduating students

2. In Response to United States Department of Education Office of Migrant Education guidance:

Federal Program Monitoring and Support Division

- Refined PowerSchool to include "MSIX ID"
 - Integrate Migrant Student reporting to the Federal Government Migrant Student Information Exchange (MSIX) system

3. In Response to the G.S. §115C-366: "Assignment of student to a particular school" Accountability

- Refined PowerSchool to include "Responsible Accountability School"
 - Data was previously collected outside of PowerSchool manually

4. In Response to the G.S. §115C-366: "Assignment of student to a particular school" Accountability

- Refined PowerSchool to include additional "Non Content Visitor" The Non Content Visitor refers to parentally placed private/home school students who receive services through a service plan and are not required to be tested. In cases where a parentally placed student in a home/private school attends a public school through a service plan, such as speech therapy, the student may be enrolled as a visitor. The student is not eligible for participation in the North Carolina Testing Program unless the student also enrolls in a content area course.
