

The Plant Operation Section in the Safe and Healthy Schools Support Division assists each local school administrative unit with effective management of the learning environment with respect to air quality, energy, environmental stewardship, hazardous materials and water and waste water quality as well as effective control of maintenance/construction costs, utility/operations costs, and protection of current school assets.

Given the current economic conditions, many school districts are faced with maintaining older (but still useful) facilities. Schools across the state depend on the Department of Public Instruction's Plant Operation Section to provide experienced professional engineering for effective solutions to their facility related issues. Plant Operation streamlines facility maintenance by (1) providing technical consulting and (2) professional design solutions uniquely tailored for the public schools. These services are available to all of the schools of North Carolina and are especially invaluable in areas where services are scarce or unaffordable. With more than half of the North Carolina's school districts identified as low wealth, the technical assistance provided by this Section is vital to those counties that may be unable to afford private consulting services. Through wide-ranging professional services, this Section effectively ensures facilities are conducive to a safe and cost effective learning environment.
