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### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

North Carolina General Statute 115C-175.6(d), as established in NC Session Law 2016-110 (HB 1080, Section 1), directs the following:

"By January 15 annually, the State Board of Education and the [Achievement School District] ASD Superintendent shall report to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee [JLEOC] on all aspects of operation of ASD, including the selection of achievement schools and their progress."

The State Board of Education, in compliance with this statute, has begun the search for the Achievement School District (ASD) Superintendent, who, as directed in the statute, will begin the process of recommending schools for the ASD. Once retained, the ASD Superintendent, consistent with statute, will provide a comprehensive report to the JLEOC regarding "all aspects of operation of the ASD, including the selection of achievement schools and their progress."
