## Forgivable Education Loans for Service Annual Report for 2016-2017 State Education Assistance Authority December 1, 2017

The North Carolina General Assembly created the Forgivable Education Loans for Service (FELS) program in 2011 to provide financial assistance in the form of forgivable loans to qualified students who are committed to working in North Carolina to lessen identified critical employment shortages. The legislation merged many older programs into one fund designed to be flexible, so that the State can respond to current as well as future employment shortages in the State.

The annual appropriation for the 2016-17 year was \$16,594,166 and a total of \$21,186,002 was loaned to 2,114 students under the FELS program.
