Report Requirements

Summary of the Legislation

The Advanced Course Teacher Bonus provides funding to reward teachers of students who achieve successful results on advanced course examinations. The state recognizes Advanced Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate (IB), and Cambridge International Certification of Education (AICE) courses as advanced courses. Each Local Education Agency (LEA) and public school is entitled to funding based on the exam results of their students. The bonus is based on exams taken in the 2016-17 school year, specified as \$50 per exam at a grade of 3 or above on AP, 4 or above on IB, and "E" or higher on AICE examinations, with a maximum of \$3,500 per teacher per year. To be eligible the teacher must be teaching in the same LEA or public school at least from the school year the data is collected until the corresponding school year that the bonus is paid.

N.C.G.S. § G.S. 2017 – 57, Section 8.8 modifies the Advanced Placement/International Baccalaureate/Cambridge AICE Teacher Bonus Program in the following ways:

- Cambridge AICE Program added to the definition of advanced courses.
- Maximum award per teacher increased to \$3,500.
- Removes the requirement to teach advanced courses in the following year to be eligible.
- Removes the requirement to be a licensed teacher to be eligible.
- Includes all public school teachers (LEAs, charter schools, regional school, Lab schools).

Reporting Requirement

The State Board of Education is reporting on advanced course teacher performance and on the amount of bonuses awarded to advanced course teachers in each LEA and public school. Because N.C.G.S. § G.S. 2017 – 57, Section 8.8 modifies the Advanced Course Teacher Bonus Program by removing the requirement to teach advanced courses in the following year to be eligible, current data analysis does not provide sufficient evidence on the effect of the program on teacher retention. This will be done in subsequent years when there is more data available.

Distribution of Funds

The Department of Public Instruction (DPI) distributed the funds to the LEAs and charter schools based on legislation and SBE policy. The allocations are available by LEA and charter school in the table below.

The allocations are an estimate by LEA and charter school based on the number of exams eligible for a bonus, as reported by the College Board and International Baccalaureate Organization. The 2017-18 school year is the first school year in which Cambridge AICE exams will be taken in North Carolina, so no allocations were distributed to LEAs or charter schools for Cambridge AICE exams in 2017. These allocations are the maximum that will be paid out and due to the eligibility requirements of the teacher and the cap, it is anticipated that not all the funds will be dispersed. At the time of the report, final expenditures by LEAs and charter schools were not available.

NCDPI allocated a total of \$4,088,767 for the Advanced Course Bonus Program for the 16-17 school year, including \$3,801,502 for 70,627 AP eligible exams and a total of \$287,265 for 5,337 IB eligible exams.
