Headcount of English Learners in North Carolina Public Schools as of October 1, 2018

This report provides the headcount of English Learners (ELs) in North Carolina Public Schools as of October 1, 2018. In accordance with SL 2003-284, Section 7.15(b), the Department of Public Instruction is required to prepare a headcount of all English Learners (ELs), and in accordance with *SL 2014-115, sec 86,87*, this report is to be submitted to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee by December 15 of each year.

The current enrollment of those students identified and assessed as English Learners in accordance with the policies of the State Board of Education (SBE) as of October 1, 2018, is 116,357, an increase of 7,693 from last year.

The report includes an accompanying table which lists the number of students by all 116 Local Education Agencies (LEAs), special schools, and the 157 of 185 charter schools who have identified English Learners. LEA and special/charter school-designated EL Coordinators reported the data electronically to NCDPI via the state electronic Student Information System (PowerSchool). In adherence with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) (20 U.S.C. § 1232g; 34 CFR Part 99), the data is suppressed where less than ten students are identified as EL (small cell suppression rule).
