COMMISSION MEETING – 8 March 2006

The Environmental Review Commission (Commission) will meet at 9:30 a.m. Wednesday 8 March 2006 in Room 544 of the Legislative Office Building in Raleigh. At the 8 March meeting, the Commission will hear a report on issues related to the evaluation of alternative animal waste management technologies to determine whether those technologies are environmentally superior and economically feasible, as well as reports from State agencies related to water quality and animal waste management. COMMISSION MEETING – 14 and 15 March 2006

The Commission will meet at the North Carolina Zoological Park in Asheboro, North Carolina, on Tuesday 14 March and Wednesday 15 March 2006. This meeting will focus primarily on various matters related to parks and recreation, land conservation, and open space preservation and will be held in connection with a tour of the Zoological Park and other site visits in the area on those days. A formal meeting notice, including a detailed itinerary for the meeting and site visits will be forthcoming. For planning purposes, the Commission Clerk will be contacting members of the Commission over the next week to determine their availability for the meeting and site visits. Information on accommodations will also be forthcoming.
