7		SECT	<b>FION 1.</b> G.S. 130A-309.10(c) reads as rewritten:
8	"(c)	(1)	No plastic bag shall be provided at any retail outlet to any retail
9			customer to use for the purpose of carrying items purchased by that
10			customer unless the bag is composed of material that is recyclable.
11		(2)	It is the goal of the State that at least twenty-five percent
12			(25%) (75%) of the plastic bags provided at retail outlets in the State to
13			retail customers for carrying items purchased by the customer be
14			recycled.
15		<u>(3)</u>	A retailer that (i) owns or controls more than 10,000 square feet of
16			retail space in the State, and (ii) provides retail customers plastic bags
17			for carrying items purchased shall:
18			<u>a.</u> <u>Implement a plastic bag collection program that facilitates the</u>
19			return and recycling of plastic bags provided to customers by
20			that retailer.
21			<u>b.</u> Provide a clearly marked receptacle for the collection of plastic
22			bags that is in a convenient location at each retail outlet owned
23			or controlled by the retailer.
24			c. Arrange for the pick-up, transport, and recycling of plastic bags
25			deposited in the collection receptacles provided."
