2	AN ACT TO MAKE ADJUSTMENTS TO THE FEE SCHEDULE FOR PERMITS FOR			
3	SANITARY LANDFILLS AND TRANSFER STATIONS TO REFLECT EXTENSION			
4	OF THE DURATION OF THESE PERMITS AS DIRECTED BY S.L. 2012-187, AS			
5	RECOMMENDED BY THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW COMMISSION.			
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:			
7	SECTION 1. G.S. 130A-294 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:			
8	"(a2) Permits for sanitary landfills and transfer stations shall be issued for: (i) a design			
9	and operation phase of five years, or (ii) a design and operation phase of ten years. A permit			
10	issued for a design and operation of phase of ten years shall be subject to a limited review			
11	within five years of the issuance date."			
12	SECTION 2. G.S. 130A-295.8 reads as rewritten:			
13	"§ 130A-295.8. Fees applicable to permits for solid waste management facilities.			
14	(a) The Solid Waste Management Account is established as a nonreverting account			
15	within the Department. All fees collected under this section shall be credited to the Account			
16	and shall be used to support the solid waste management program established pursuant to			
17	G.S. 130A-294.

5 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law, and applies to permit 6 applications submitted on or after July 1, 2013.
