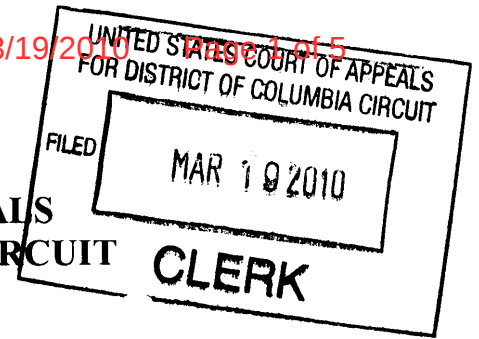

ALCOA POWER GENERATING INC.**


Pursuant to Rule 26.1 of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure and Circuit Rule 26.1 of the rules of this Court, Alcoa Power Generating Inc. (hereinafter “APGI”) submits the following disclosure statement:

Alcoa Power Generating Inc. is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Alcoa Inc. Alcoa Inc. is a publicly-held corporation, incorporated in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, primarily engaged in the production and manufacture of aluminum metal and aluminum products around the world. No other publicly-held company has a 10percent or greater ownership interest in Alcoa Inc.

APGI holds the majority of Alcoa Inc.’s electric utility assets that serve its primary aluminum operations in the United States. Amongst other things, APGI owns and is the licensee of the Yadkin Hydroelectric Project No. 2197 located on

the Yadkin River, in Stanly, Montgomery, Davidson, and Rowan Counties, North Carolina.
