In replay to the commit made at the last meeting on guidance documents, I would like to point out the attached document which is clearly marked guidance. This document is being given to developers to use to restrict wetlands, when currently there are no rules in place to restrict them. If DWQ can give guidance to restrict wetlands (which again there is no rule that restricts wetlands) then why can't they issue guidance documents for their staff to use to help them figure out what the original intent of the rule is. The NC Building Code book is full of diagrams and tables, and we build 100's of houses a year and might have one disagreement with building inspectors a year. However I feel that anytime we go to DWQ for our permit it is a battle over interpretations, that change from year to year.
