### Plan Review Procedures for Review of Engineered Stormwater Management Plan Submittals Permit Number NCS000474

### Pursuant to S.L. 2014-120, Sec. 29 Reform Agency Review of Engineering Work

The procedures and conditions contained herein are applicable to plan submittals for projects located in the co-permitted municipalities of Cajah's Mountain, Gamewell, Granite Falls, Hudson, Lenoir, and Sawmills, in Caldwell County and subject to the conditions set forth in the Caldwell County Phase II Stormwater Ordinance. The City of Lenoir administers the Phase II Stormwater Management Program for the co-permitted municipalities and conducts all plan reviews for post-construction stormwater controls for projects within these jurisdictional areas.

Pursuant to S.L. 2014-120, Sec. 29.(b)(1)

While conducting reviews of post-construction stormwater management plan submittals, review officers will identify and differentiate between plan changes that are deemed necessary by statutory requirement or other legal authorities and plan changes that are suggestions for improvement but not required by a valid legal mechanism.

Notification of any required or requested plan modifications will be made to the submitting party in writing at such time as the review officer issues formal comments of the plan review.

Pursuant to S.L. 2014-120, Sec. 29.(b)(2)

During the course of any post-construction stormwater management plan review, when deficiencies, errors, or omissions in the plan submittal are noted by the review officer and will result in delay of permit issuance, the required revision(s) or request(s) for additional information will be accompanied by citation of the supporting statutory or regulatory authorities warranting such revisions.

At such time the review officer issues formal written comments of the plan review to the submitting party, any required revisions or requests for additional information will be accompanied by a reference to the statutory or regulatory authorities warranting such revisions.

Pursuant to S.L. 2014-120, Sec. 29.(c)(1)

The City of Lenoir has adopted the North Carolina State Stormwater BMP Manual to function as the Design Manual for post-construction stormwater management control devices. In the event a plan is submitted for review and permitting by a qualified Professional Engineer that does not meet requirements or design guidance contained in the BMP Manual, the submitting party may request additional review by the review officer's supervisor, the City of Lenoir Planning

Director; the delegating state agency, the North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Division of Land Quality; or a qualified Professional Engineer of the reviewing agency's choice. The submitting party will be responsible for any and all fees that may result from a review by a third party. A list of participating Professional Engineers is maintained by the City of Lenoir Stormwater Administrator.

In an effort to expedite the review process, during the pre-submittal consultation the submitting party may notify the reviewing agency of the proposed design and request supplemental and/or additional review.

Pursuant to S.L. 2014-120, Sec. 29.(c)(2)

During the course of a plan review where the review officer has identified deficiencies, errors, or omissions in the plan and appropriately cited the supporting statutory or regulatory authorities requiring plan modification, the submitting party may request additional review and/or interpretation of requirements by the review officer's supervisor, the City of Lenoir Planning Director; the delegating state agency, the North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Division of Land Quality; or a qualified Professional Engineer of the reviewing agency's choice. The submitting party will be responsible for any and all fees that may result from a review by a third party. A list of participating Professional Engineers is maintained by the City of Lenoir Stormwater Administrator.

In the event of a dispute between the review officer and the submitting party regarding required plan modifications, the submitting party may, after receiving written notification of the required changes from the review officer, request additional review. Any such request should be made in writing to the review officer. In an effort to expedite the plan review, requests for additional review should be made at the earliest reasonable date following the submitting party's receipt of the review officer's comments.
