 - Businesses research and manufacturing of pharmaceuticals, vaccines, medical devices
 - Academia universities statewide
- Jobs and economic benefits from products and services to improve health in low and low-to-middle income countries

Non-Profit RTI, FHI, Ipas, IntraHealth	3,400	\$267 million	\$1 billion
Business Pharmaceutical, Diagnostics, Medical/Lab Equipment & supplies	3,000	\$ 220 million	\$591 million
Academia UNC-CH, Duke Global Health Institute, Wake Forest, UNC-G, ECU, NCCU	581	\$21 million	\$51 million

19.5% of all N.C. exports to low and low-to-middle income countries (exports to Canada = 24.4%)
