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What is NC FAST ?

North Carolina Families Accessing Services through Technology

- **Software solution to deliver state benefits and services at the county level for all 100 NC local DSS's**
- **Counties now manage case information for Medicaid eligibility, Food and Nutrition Services, Child Care, and Energy programs in one system**
- **Replaces 20 legacy systems upon full transition**
- **Shares client data across all benefitting programs**
- **Applies federal rules, built into the system**
- **Collects data for individual eligibility and case management and program, county, and state level outputs and performance measures**
- **90% business process change management, 10% technology**

NC FAST Guiding Principles

- **Partner with and add value to system users and stakeholders – front line staff, managers, administrators, and policymakers**
- **Support accurate and timely administration of programs to assure compliance and integrity**
- **Focus on quality service delivery, efficiency and accountability**
- **Share ownership of problems and solutions with DHHS program and IT staff and county DSS's**

NC FAST Projects

Completed Projects

- **Global Case Management and Food and Nutrition Services**
 - Full implementation to all 100 counties was completed in March 2013.
- **Medicaid, Work First, Special Assistance, and Refugee Assistance**
 - Full implementation to all 100 counties was completed in November 2014.
- **Federally-Facilitated Marketplace Interoperability**
 - Full implementation to all 100 counties was completed in June 2016.

In-Process Projects

- **Subsidized Child Care Assistance, Crisis Intervention and Low Income Energy Assistance**
- **Child Welfare Services**
- **Medicaid Self Service and Enterprise Program Integrity**
- **Document Management System Enhancement**

Adult Services has not been initiated at this time

NC FAST Metrics

- 6,500 users daily in all 100 counties
- 4,430 individuals have accessed one or more of 44 online training modules
