Cherry Hospital Update

Bed Capacity

- Former Campus: 197 beds
- New Campus: 294 beds (97 additional beds)
- Currently open: 243 beds
- Beds remaining to be opened: 51 beds

Cherry Staffing

- Recruitment of 158 clinical positions needed to open the remaining
 51 beds
 - Positions: 5 psychiatrists, 64 registered nurses (RNs), 52 Health
 Care Technicians (HCTs) and 37 other
 - All positions are budgeted/funded

DHHS will continue to offer updates on these efforts

Broughton Hospital Update

Bed Capacity

- Current Campus: 297 beds
- New Campus: 382 beds (85 additional beds)

New Broughton Staffing & Equipment

- Additional positions will be needed to open the additional 85 beds
 - Positions include psychiatrists, registered nurses (RNs), Health
 Care Technicians (HCTs) and others
 - Positions are not budgeted/funded
- Funding for equipment & furniture not fully identified
- DHHS will continue to offer updates on these needs

October 10, 2017 based on 2/16/2017 email from AWC to DHHS

December 29, 2017 based on 4/3/2017 DHHS, DOJ, P+W, AWC, and Travelers meeting

March - May 2018 based on 6/16/2017 Takeover Agreement

Takeover Agreement Between DHHS & Travelers

- Takeover Agreement (TOA) requirements:
 - Travelers to hire Completing Contractor (AWC)
 - Travelers to hire Construction Manager (Vertex)
 - Travelers to hire Scheduler (Delta)
 - Travelers to provide DHHS with bi-weekly schedule update
 - Liquidated Damages tripled
 - DHHS to hire an additional Owner's Representative (RPA Design)
 - DHHS' & Travelers' scheduling consultants to meet bi-weekly
- New Final Acceptance date set for March-May, 2018
 - Liquidated damages will be assessed if not met

Delays: Construction

- Lack of adequate project management
- Lack of quality control
- Lack of sufficient manpower (until recently)
- Lack of site management and protection of soils
- Key construction issues include:
 - Correcting 60% of floors for elevation discrepancy issue
 - Removing and replacing 40% of sprayed-on fireproofing
 - Rework for misalignment of pedestrian bridge at East Staff Entrance
 - Rework for removing and replacing improper floor topping
 - Rework to correct anchoring of curtain wall system
 - Removing/replacing framing and soils
