- **\$2M allocated from the Dorothea Dix Hospital Property Fund for the construction of Facility Based Crisis Beds for Children/Adolescents**

- Competitive statewide bidding process; two awardees
- Awards have been given & contracts have been executed

- **\$18M allocated from the Dorothea Dix Hospital Property Fund for the conversion/construction of licensed short-term, inpatient Behavioral Health Beds**

- Competitive bidding process in three State regions – Eastern, Central, & Western; one awardee per region
- Awards have been given & contracts in development for all awardees; expected contract executions in early 2018
