

Report to the North Carolina General Assembly Smart Start Program Match Report Session Law 2018-5 Section 11B.8.(d)

Background

The North Carolina Partnership for Children (NCPC) and local partnerships are required to match 19% of funds allocated by the General Assembly through cash and in-kind contributions. Per SL 2018-5, Section 11B.8.(d), "Of the funds the North Carolina Partnership for Children, Inc., and the local partnerships are required to match, contributions of cash shall be equal to at least thirteen percent (13%) and in-kind donated resources shall be equal to no more than six percent (6%) for a total match requirement of nineteen percent (19%) for each year of the 2017-2019 fiscal biennium."

FY 2017-18 Reporting

Under Session Law 2018-5, Section 11B.8.(d), the North Carolina General Assembly requires that NCPC report on the private cash and in-kind contributions received by Local Partnerships and NCPC by October 1 of each year. This report is submitted to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Health and Human Services in response to that requirement.
