Dear Chairmen:

Session Law 2021-180, Section 9F.7(c) requires the Department of Health and Human Services to resume the adult and pediatric traumatic brain injury pilot program (TBI pilot program) and to report to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Health and Human Services and the Fiscal Research on the number and outcome of patients served at each program site, a breakdown of expenditures at each program site by type of service, an estimate of the cost to expand the program incrementally and statewide, an estimate of any potential savings of State funds associated with expansion of the program and if the expansion of the TBI pilot program is recommended, a time line and plan for expanding the program. This report is due on or before April 1, 2022.


