- There are 4 units that provide 16/7 coverage in our close custody facilities.
- There are 15 units that provide 16/5 coverage in our medium custody facilities.
- There are 15 units that provide 8/5 coverage in our minimum custody facilities.

- Currently 17.4% of total adult offenders are over age 50
- Over 36% of total adult offenders are receiving care in one of our many medical chronic care clinics:

- 13% of our total adult offenders receive mental health treatment in the form of medication management, individual or group therapy.
