The federal government has stronger, longer sentences

Sentencing

Case Type	Average Federal Sentence	Analogous State Sentence
Firearm Cases	6 years	Probation
Drug Cases	5 years	Probation
Other Violent Felonies	15 years	3.5 years

Crimes that are prosecuted federally are not prosecuted at the state level

Criminals who are incarcerated federally are not in North Carolina's Department of Correction

One SAUSA Savings to State Courts

Cost of State Prosecution – Class D Felony	\$	3,465
2013 Defendants Prosecuted by 1 SAUSA	X	32
Total Annual State Savings	\$ 2	110,880
