In response to S.L. 2018-69 (H.B. 379) the North Carolina Board of Landscape Architects hereby submits the below.

N.C. Gen. Stat. § 89A-8(a) only provides that using the title "Landscape Architect" or holding oneself out as entitled to practice landscape architecture is a Class 2 misdemeanor. It does not make violation of an administrative rule a crime. Therefore none of the Board's rules constitute a crime.
