Re: Crimes Report

Dear Committee Members,

Pursuant to Session Law 2018-69, House Bill 379 which was ratified and became law on June 14, 2018, the North Carolina Board of Nursing ("NCBON") submits this report. The law requires the NCBON to create a list of all crimes defined by the NCBON that are in effect or pending implementation.

Article 9A, Chapter 90 of the North Carolina General Statutes is the Nursing Practice Act of North Carolina. The following is the crime defined in the law:

§ 90-171.45. Violation of Article.

The violation of any provision of this Article, except G.S. 90-171.47, shall be a Class 1 misdemeanor. (1981, c. 360, s. 1; 1993, c. 539, s. 632; 1994, Ex. Sess., c. 24, s. 14(c).)

This law is in effect and there are no other crimes defined that are in effect or pending implementation. Please feel free to contact Amy G. Fitzhugh, Chief Legal Officer of the NCBON, for any questions or concerns.
