Re: North Carolina Respiratory Care Board

The North Carolina Respiratory Care Board was established by Act of the General Assembly during its 2000 session, with the passage of the North Carolina Respiratory Care Practice Act. The Act is codified at N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-646 *et seq.* This report is being submitted at the direction of our Board Attorney in response to the HB379 requirements to “create a list of all crimes defined by the agency, board, or commission that are in effect or pending implementation.” As such, N.C.G.S § 90-662 established that “any person who violates any provision of this Article shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor (2000-162, s. 1.)”. We have no other established crimes pending implementation. Violations are defined in N.C.G.S § 90-659 and 21 NCAC 61 .0307.

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
