RE: Reporting Requirement: Session Law 2018-69

Dear Chair Boles and Chair Davis:

As you are aware, Session Law 2018-69 directs "all State agencies, boards, and commissions that have the power to define conduct as a crime in the North Carolina Administrative Code" to submit to the Joint Legislative Administrative Procedure Oversight Committee and the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Justice and Public Safety a list of all such crimes in effect or pending implementation.

The North Carolina State Board of Education has not defined any conduct in the North Carolina Administrative Code as a crime. Nor does the Board have any rules pending implementation to that effect.
