## NOTE re GENERAL PENALTY in CODE

County code § 1-11 imposes a general penalty as a default penalty "where no specific penalty is provided" for a given section. The general penalty for acts "declared to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor" is a fine of not more than \$50.00 or imprisonment for not more than 30 days.

**Special note**: Penalties regarding imposition of the privilege license tax sections (from Chapter 7) are not listed, in light of repeal of the privilege license tax provisions formerly in the North Carolina General Statutes.
