Monetary penalties shall be as follows: 1 violation \$50, 2 violations \$100, 3 violations \$200. (B) At a minimum, on the third violation further criminal action will be taken. (C) In addition, enforcement of this chapter may be by appropriate equitable remedy, injunction, or order of abatement issuing from a court of competent jurisdiction pursuant. (D) In addition to, and not in lieu of, the criminal penalties and other sanctions provided in this chapter, a violation of this chapter may also subject the offender to civil penalties.

Each day that said automobile graveyard or junkyard shall be maintained or operated in violation of this chapter shall constitute a separate and distinct offense. (B) In lieu of or in addition to the criminal penalties outlined above, any person violating this chapter may be subject to the remedies outlined in G.S 153A-123 including civil penalties, not to exceed \$500. No penalty shall be assessed prior to notice of the violation. For every day a person is in violation of this chapter, it may be considered a separate offense. If the violator does not pay such penalty within 30 days of notification of this assessment by written citation it may be recovered by the county in civil action in the nature of debt. The violator may contest said penalty in the court of appropriate jurisdiction.

The county may as a first remedy issue a civil fine of \$50 for noise nuisance violation.

Any person who violates this chapter or fails to comply with any of its requirements shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined, as set forth in the county fee schedule, or imprisoned for not more than 30 days, or both. Each day such violation continues shall be considered a separate offense. Nothing herein contained shall prevent the county from taking such other lawful action as is necessary to prevent or remedy any violation</p>

(B) The description by metes and bounds in the instrument of transfer or other document used in the process of selling or transferring land shall not exempt the transaction from this penalty. The county, through its attorney or other official designated by the County Board of Commissioners, may enjoin illegal subdivision, transfer, or sale of land by action for injunction. Further, violators of this chapter shall be subject, upon conviction, to fine and/or imprisonment as provided by G.S. 14-4</p>
