Addressing and Road Naming Ordinance	Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of misdemeanor and shall be subject to a fine of not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) or imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days, as provided by Geneal Statue 14-4.	05/15/2000
Abandoned and Junked Motor Vehicle	Violation of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor and shall be punishable as provided in G.S. 14-4	11/21/2005
Regulating Unsafe Buildings	The violation of any provision of the ordiance shall constitute a misdemeanor, as provided by G. S. 14-4	02/18/2008
