

Ordinance	Description of Regulated Conduct Subject to Criminal Prosecution
Comprehensive Animal Services Ordinance (Animal Control Ordinance No. 5)	Regulates animal cruelty and neglect, dogs running at large, dangerous dogs, large commercial breeders, and dangerous exotic animals.
Emergency Management Ordinance (Emergency Management Ordinance No. 1)	Establishes emergency management agency.
State of Emergency (Emergency Management Ordinance No. 2)	Imposes restrictions during state of emergencies such as curfews, evacuations, prohibitions on possession of weapons or alcoholic beverages in certain areas.
Fire Prevention Ordinance (Emergency Management Ordinance No. 3)	Prohibits open burning and fire code violations.
EMS System Oversight Ordinance (Emergency Management Ordinance No. 4)	Establishes committee for oversight of emergency medical service providers and creates franchise system for non-emergency ambulance operators.
Ordinance to Regulate the Utilization of the Pitt County Recreation Complex (Facility Services Ordinance No. 2)	Prohibits violations of rules and regulations established for the Pitt County Recreation Complex.
Personnel Ordinance (Human Resources Ordinance No. 1)	Comprehensive ordinance regarding employee selection, promotion, dismissal, and creates rules for employee conduct, and provides other employment procedures.
Noise Ordinance (Law Enforcement Ordinance No. 1)	Prohibits loud, disturbing and unnecessary noises
Ordinance Governing Hunting in Pitt County (Law Enforcement Ordinance No. 2)	Regulates hunting, including limitations on proximity to residential homes without permission, hunting on posted land, hunting across roads, hunting on posted land, releasing hunting dogs on posted land.
An Ordinance to Prohibit Trespassing Within 25 Feet of any Fenced Enclosure at the Pitt County Detention Center to Prevent the Conveyance of Contraband Forbidden to Inmates by Jail Rules (Law Enforcement Ordinance No. 3)	Prohibits trespassing within 25 feet of fenced enclosures at Pitt County Detention Center, the throwing of contraband over any fence at the Detention Center, or otherwise conveying contraband to inmates.

Ordinance Prohibiting the Carrying of Deadly Weapons in Pitt County Buildings and Permitting the Posting of Signs to Prohibit the Carrying of Deadly Weapons in Pitt County Buildings (Law Enforcement Ordinance No. 4)	Prohibits carrying deadly weapons in county owned buildings.
Ordinance Prohibiting Skateboarding and Other Similar Activities on Pitt County Property Without Written Permission of the Board of Commissioners (Law Enforcement Ordinance No. 6)	Prohibits skateboarding, roller skating, or roller blading on county owned property.
Unmanned Aircraft System Ordinance (Law Enforcement Ordinance No. 7)	Regulates the landing and takeoff of unmanned aircraft system (drones).
Cable Communications Ordinance (Office of Public Information Ordinance No. 1)	Regulatory provisions requiring cable communication companies to obtain franchise.
Addressing (Planning & Development Services Ordinance No. 1)	Requires that street numbers be posted on addressed structures, or by the road, or both in certain circumstances.
Ordinance Regulating Adult Establishment Sexually Oriented Businesses (Planning & Development Services Ordinance No. 2)	Requires that sexually oriented businesses obtain a license and operate under certain conditions and restrictions.
Building Codes Enforcement Ordinance (Planning & Development Services Ordinance No. 3)	Requires building construction to follow permitting and inspection procedures and to comply with State Building Code.
Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance (Planning & Development Services Ordinance No. 4)	Regulates development in designated floodplains.
Manufactured Home Parks (Planning & Development Services Ordinance No. 5)	Regulates the creation of manufactured home parks .(mobile home park).
Outdoor Advertising Signs (Planning & Development Services Ordinance No. 7)	Regulates outdoor advertising signs.

Riparian Buffer Protection Ordinance (Planning & Development Services Ordinance No. 8)	Regulates vegetation within riparian buffers, 50 yards within surface waters.
Shooting Range Regulations (Planning & Development Services Ordinance No. 9)	Requires that outdoor shooting ranges (firearm ranges) obtain a permit and operate under certain conditions and restrictions.
Soil Erosion and Sedimentation Control Ordinance (Planning & Development Services Ordinance No. 10)	Regulates land disturbing activities contributing to soil and sedimentation erosion.
Stormwater Management Ordinance for Nutrient Control (Planning & Development Services Ordinance No. 11)	Prohibits violation of minimum stormwater management requirements and controls.
Subdivision Ordinance (Planning & Development Services Ordinance No. 12)	Regulates the subdivision of land for development, requiring review and compliance with standards.
Zoning Ordinance (Planning & Development Services Ordinance No. 14)	Regulates land use (commercial, industrial, residential), including development regulations regarding design, density, setbacks.
Voluntary Agricultural District Ordinance (Planning & Development Services Ordinance No. 15)	Creates voluntary agricultural districts and the Pitt County Agricultural Advisory Board.
Franchise Ordinance for Construction Debris Landfills (Solid Waste & Recycling Ordinance No. 1)	Requires construction and debris landfills to obtain a franchise approval from the County and operate under certain conditions and restrictions.
Junk Motor Vehicles (Solid Waste & Recycling Ordinance No. 2)	Regulates the disposal and possession of inoperable, dismantled, and damaged motor vehicles.
Solid Waste Recycling, Collection and Disposal Ordinance (Solid Waste & Recycling Ordinance No. 3)	Regulates what materials may be disposed at Pitt County Solid Waste facilities, establishes rules for operated and disposing of waste at County facilities, and prohibits the disposal and accumulation of garbage at other properties.
Occupancy Tax (Tax Administration Ordinance No. 1)	Requires that hotels and other lodging providers collect and report occupancy tax.
Ordinance Levying Tax on Gross Receipts Derived from Retail Short-Term Leases or Rental of Motor Vehicles (Tax Administration Ordinance No. 2)	Requires the collection and payment of taxes on short term motor vehicle leases and rentals.
