| Ordinance Punishable by G.S. 14-4(a) | Description of Conduct Subject to Criminal Punishment under the Ordinance | Other Notes |
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| An Ordinance to Regulate the Speed of Boats and Watercraft on Certain Waterways Within the Boundaries of Tyrrell County. | Misdemeanor, and shall be fined not more than fifty (\$50.00) dollars or imprisoned for not more than thirty (30) days pursuant to Chapter 14, Article 1, Section 4 of the North Carolina General Statutes. | |
| Tyrrell County Building Permit Fee Schedule Ordinance | Violation will result in a \$50 penalty added to the permit fees due. Payment of such penalty shall not relieve the violator of criminal prosecution. | |
| Resolution Authorizing Establishment of an Ordinance Levying Tax on Gross Receipts Derived from Retail Short-Term Lease or Rental of Motor Vehicles | Any person, firm, corporation or association who willfully attempts in any manner to evade a tax imposed herein or who willfully fails to pay the tax or make and file a return shall in addition to the penalties provided by law and herein, be guilty of misdemeanor punishable as provided by law. | |

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| Tyrrell County Sign Ordinance | Any person placing or erecting an on-site or off-site business sign (billboard) in violation of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable as provided by G. S. 14-1 and G. S. 153-123(b), with each day considered a separate violation. | |
| Ordinance Providing for the Removal and Disposition of Abandoned, Manufactured Homes | Any owner or keeper who keeps a manufactured home in dead storage in violation of this article shall be guilty of a Class III misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of up to five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and/or a maximum of thirty (30) days in jail as provided by applicable state law. Each day's violation shall constitute a separate and distinct offense. | |

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| Recreational Vehicle Campground Ordinance | Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance or failing or neglecting or refusing to comply with the same, shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor and subject to a fine not to exceed twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars per campground space, per day and/or imprisonment not to exceed thirty (30) days. Each day that any of the provisions of this ordinance are violated shall constitute a separate offense. | |
| Manufactured Home Park Prohibition Ordinance | Class 1 misdemeanor and subject to a fine not to exceed twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars per manufactured home space, per day and/or imprisonment not to exceed thirty (30) days. Each day that the provisions of this ordinance are violated shall constitute a separate offense. | |
| Wind Energy Facilities Ordinance | Class 1 misdemeanor and subject to a fine not to exceed Five-Hundred (\$500.00) dollars per day, per turbine and/or imprisonment not to exceed one hundred twenty (120) days. Each day that the provisions of this ordinance are violated shall constitute a separate offense. | |

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| Animal Control Ordinance | Class 3 misdemeanor, Criminal action may be initiated by any police officer or animal control officer. | |
| An Ordinance to Regulate the Construction, Maintenance, and Removal of Solar Energy Facilities | Any person violating any provision of the Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished for each offense not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) or imprisonment not to exceed thirty (30) days. Each day such violation continues shall be deemed to be a separate offense. | |
| Tyrrell County Subdivision Ordinance | Class 1 misdemeanor | |
| An Ordinance Imposing a Monthly Charge Upon Telephone Subscribers in Tyrrell County for Enhanced 911 Service | Any person who intentionally calls the 911 number for other than purposes of obtaining public safety assistance commits a misdemeanor. | |

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| Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance | Violation of the provisions of this ordinance or failure to comply with any of its requirements, including violation of conditions and safeguards established in connection with grants of variance or special exceptions, shall constitute a misdemeanor. Any person who violates this ordinance or fails to comply with any of its requirements shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not more than \$50.00 or imprisoned for not more than thirty (30) days, or both. Each day such violation continues shall be considered a separate offense. Nothing herein contained shall prevent Tyrrell County from taking such other lawful action as is necessary to prevent or remedy any violation. | |
| Tyrrell County Animal Control Ordinance | Class 3 misdemeanor, Criminal action may be initiated by any police officer or animal control officer. | |
| An Ordinance to Regulate the Construction, Maintenance and Removal of Solar Energy Facilities | Misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished for each offense not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) or imprisonment not to exceed thirty (30) days. Each day such violation continues shall be deemed to be a separate offense. | |

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| Wind Energy Facilities Ordinance | Class 1 misdemeanor and subject to fine not to exceed five hundred (\$500.00) dollars per day, not to exceed one hundred and twenty (120) days. Each day that the provisions of the Ordinance are violated shall constitute a separate offense. | |
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
