Under G.S. 14-4, the absence of a specific higher amount results in a penalty of \$50.00.

NOTES RE TOWN'S GENERAL PENALTY SECTION

City Code § 1-8 provides, in pertinent part: "Unless otherwise specifically provided, violation of any provision of this Code or any other town ordinance shall be a misdemeanor, as provided by G.S. 14-4."

- G.S. § 160A-175(b) provides: "Unless the council shall otherwise provide, violation of a town ordinance is a misdemeanor or infraction as provided by G.S. 14-4. An ordinance may provide by express statement that the maximum fine, term of incarceration, or infraction penalty to be imposed for a violation is some amount of money or number of days less than the maximum imposed by G.S. 14-4.
- G.S. § 14-4 provides, in pertinent part: "Any person [who] shall violate an ordinance ... shall be guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than \$500.00. No fine shall exceed \$50.00 unless the ordinance expressly states that the maximum fine is greater than \$50.00."
- G.S. § 14-3 provides that the maximum punishment for a Class 3 misdemeanor is a fine of up to \$500.00 and incarceration of up to 30 days.
