33.07	Violating any provision of any restriction imposed by any proclamation authorized by this chapter during a state of emergency.
33.08	Crossing a police emergency line or remaining within the area bounded by the police emergency line after being ordered by a police officer to leave
35.20	Failure to pay the tax to the Tax Collector in the form and manner required.
51.03	Prohibiting or preventing weekly solid waste collection services at a premises.
51.09	Causing or allowing solid waste to be placed, deposited, or accumulated on property, except in proper receptacles.
51.12	Failure to follow the regulations governing the disposal of recyclables.
51.30	Unauthorized scavenging, sorting, picking through, or removal of refuse, trash, yard waste, or recyclables set out for collection.
51.32	Unauthorized trash or recycling collection.
51.34	Illegally dumping on public streets, sidewalks, alleys, any property not owned by a person without written permission, or into any body of water.
51.35	Burning garbage and yard waste.
51.36	Use of town garbage collection services by non-residents.
51.37	Maintaining or operating a disposal site for the burial of material resulting from building, construction, renovation, or demolition.
51.38	Transportation of unsecured or loose wastes or materials.
51.51	Placing junk appliances out for curbside collection. Leaving any appliance, refrigerator or container outside and accessible to children without it being strapped or locked to prevent access by a child.
51.65	Placing prohibited types of solid waste in any container or receptacle intended for collection by the town.
52.03	Connecting to the town water system without a permit.
52.06	Damaging or tampering with any part of the sewer system.

52.08	Damaging, tampering with, or turning the cutoffs on any water main or any fire hydrant valve. Releasing any water from a fire hydrant.
70.70	Failing to travel exclusively on the truck routes established by Ch. 73, Schedule VIII.
71.02	Failure to stop at the designated intersections before proceeding through.
71.03	Entering an intersection without sufficient space to cross completely without blocking the intersection or pedestrian crosswalk.
71.06	Making a left or right turn on a street where prohibited in the traffic schedule.
71.07	Making a U-turn where prohibited.
71.08	Backing into an intersection or crosswalk, or backing up in an unsafe manner.
71.09	Emerging from an alley or private driveway without stopping first.
71.10	Clinging to moving vehicles.
71.11	Riding on handlebars.
71.12	Riding a bicycle or motorcycle on sidewalks or riding either without hands on handlebars.
71.13	Using roller skates on the street unless the street is set aside as a play street.
71.17	Driving over a fire hose.
71.18	Driving on the street with vehicles or heavy equipment of any kind which have metal tracks, lugs, cleats or tires which would damage the surface.
71.19	The use of engine compression or "Jake" brakes.
71.35	Boarding or alighting from a vehicle in motion.
71.36	Riding on a public conveyance or any portion thereof not designed or intended for the use of passengers.
71.37	Entering, jumping on, or riding any vehicle without the consent of the owner or driver.
71.38	Failure of a passenger of a vehicle to keep all body parts within the limits of the vehicle.
71.39	Having more than three people in the front seat of a vehicle.
71.40	While driving, stopping in the road to speak to another driver.
72.01	Stopping, standing, or parking a vehicle in any of the prohibited locations.
72.02	Failure to park parallel to the curb.
72.03	Parking in an alley leaving less than ten feet of width in the roadway for other vehicles.
72.08	Parking a vehicle along a yellow-painted curb.

72.09	Parking with the driver's side close to the curb.
72.11	Double diagonal parking.
72.13	Parking a vehicle on any public street for the purposes of displaying it for sale, washing, repairing, storage, or storage of a trailer.
72.14	Parking a vehicle on any street for the primary purpose of advertising.
72.15	Parking in a prohibited area or sufficiently far from the curb to make the distance unlawful.
72.16	Parking or driving on sidewalks.
72.17	Parking any boat and trailer, camper, RV, or towed vehicle and trailer on any portion of the street.
72.18	Blocking or partially blocking the entrance from any part of the property to the public street without consent of the owner.
72.70	Unauthorized parking in a handicap space.
90.16	Failure to leave a town recreation facility after having been asked by an employee or authorized agent. Trespassing on any town recreation facilities after hours.
90.17	Driving any vehicle over or through any town recreation facility except along roadways or pathways so designated. Parking outside designated parking areas. Leaving a vehicle parked and unattended longer than 12 hours.
90.18	Displaying any advertising device in any town recreation facility.
90.19	Shooting a deadly weapon, air rifle, or toy weapon capable of hurling a projectile within any town facility. Possession of a firearm where there is a posted prohibition sign. Participating in any activity considered to be hazardous within any town recreation facility.
90.20	Climbing upon any recreational building, bridge, rail, dam, cliff, boulder, or tree or attaching a rope, cable, or chain thereto for the purpose of a swing.
90.21	Permitting any horses, dogs, cats, or other animals to run at large within any recreation facility.
90.22	Trapping, catching, injuring, killing, or cruelly treating any animal or their nests, dens, etc. within any recreation facility.
90.23	Throwing rocks, bottles, dirt, or other materials within a town recreation facility or in any body of water.

90.24	Possess, consume, or display of alcoholic beverages unless authorized by the Board of Commissioners.
90.25	Littering at any town recreation facility.
90.26	Making a fire except within a fireplace or grill provided for that purpose.
90.27	Make an excavation in any town recreation facility without permission from the Director.
90.28	Digging up, cutting, bruising, or otherwise injuring any plant within a town recreation facility without permission of the Director.
90.29	Using water for any purpose other than drinking unless authorized by the Director.
90.30	Camping outside of a designated camping area.
90.31	Operating a motor vehicle within Elkin Municipal Park during the prohibited hours.
90.32	As a registered sex offender, entering any public park.
90.45	Peddling, selling, or begging without written authority from the Director.
90.46	Having a dog off leash.
91.03	Abandoning a vehicle.
91.04	Keep a hazardous vehicle on the property.
91.05	Failure to comply with an order to remove a junked vehicle. Failure to comply with the requirements for concealing a junked vehicle.
92.04	Conducting commercial enterprises on the airport without authorization by the owner.
92.05	Failure to abide by the motor vehicle regulations established by the Airport Manager.
92.06	Failure to abide by the aircraft operation regulations enumerated in this section.
92.07	Failure to abide by the rules for aircraft fueling operations.
92.08	Failure to abide by the fire regulations established in this section.
92.21	Operating a commercial enterprise at the airport without a fully executed lease agreement with the Town.
92.22	Failure to meet the requirements for aeronautical operators engaging in self-fueling.
92.23	As an operator conducting aircraft, engine, and accessory maintenance facilities, failure to comply with the requirements listed.
92.24	As an operator conducting flight training activities for compensation, failure to comply with the requirements listed.

92.25	As an operator of a charter service, failure to comply with the requirements listed.
92.26	As an operator conducting full-time aircraft rental and/or sales, failure to comply with the requirements listed.
92.30	Failure to provide services in a fair, equal, and not unjustly discriminatory basis to all users of the airport.
92.31	Denial of services based on race, age, sex, color, national origin, or ability.
92.49	Use of land or water in such a manner as to create electrical interference with navigational signals or radio communication between the airport and aircraft, making it difficult for pilots to distinguish between airport lights and others, create bird strike hazards, or otherwise endanger or interfere with landing, takeoff, or maneuvering of aircraft intending to use the airport.
94.03	Permitting an animal to run at large. Failure to remove dog poop from public areas or private property unless given permission by the owner.
94.04	Keeping a vicious animal unless kept in a secure enclosure.
94.05	Failure to maintain current rabies vaccinations for cats and dogs.
94.06	Keeping stray animals.
94.07	Permitting cats to run at large to the annoyance or nuisance of others.
94.08	Nuisance committed by an animal for which owner is responsible.
94.25	Riding or walking a horse upon the prohibited streets.
94.26	Permitting a horse to run at large.
94.27	Riding a horse at night.
94.41	Keeping livestock on fewer than eight acres of land.
94.43	Keeping swine, large mammals of prey, alligators, crocodilians, and non-domesticated animals within the town.
94.45	Keeping fowl within 200 ft. of any residential or commercial building, school or church, or other establishment.
94.46	Permitting fowl to run at large.
94.47	Failure to keep gallinaceous birds within a fence, building, or enclosure.
95.01	Permitting any of the unlawful enumerated conditions to exist on private property.

95.20	Creating an unreasonably loud, disturbing, or unnecessary noise.
95.35	Creating a loud, disturbing noise emanating from a motor vehicle.
95.36	Operating a motor vehicle in the town which has had it's noise control equipment removed. Engaging in jackrabbit starts, tire spinning, or racing engines. Public street racing.
96.019	Constructing or making a driveway cut without a permit.
96.035	Making an opening in a street or sidewalk without a permit.
96.075	Displaying goods or merchandise for sale on a public street.
97.005	Conducting a burial on Easter or Christmas.
97.007	Entering the Town Cemetery after closing hours.
97.008	Posting any advertising within the Town Cemetery.
97.009	Driving a commercial truck or wagon not engaged in cemetery business within the Town Cemetery.
97.010	Riding a horse or bicycle within the Town Cemetery.
97.011	Driving on anything other than the main roads and avenues within the Town Cemetery. Exceeding ten mph.
97.012	Parking in the cemetery unless engaged in cemetery-related activities.
97.013	Possession of firearms within the Town Cemetery.
97.014	After creating an unnecessary noise or engaging in improper conduct, refusing to leave the cemetery when notified to do so.
97.015	Defacing or removing Town Cemetery property or removing anything placed to mark a grave.
97.016	Injuring, defacing, or otherwise damaging monuments, headstones, etc.
97.017	Permitting a dog or fowl to enter the Town Cemetery.
97.018	Placing a grave mound or permanent boxes, urns, metal ornaments, seats, or similar items upon any grave or plot within the cemetery.
97.019	Planting or pruning trees, shrubs, and the like without written consent of the Town Manager and Superintendent.
110.03	Conducting a business in the town for which there is a required license without obtaining one.
110.07	Failure to prominently display a business license.

110.31	Possession of a firearm at a special event area.
111.01	Soliciting, begging, peddling, asking for money, or soliciting in or upon a vehicle, in an intimidating or aggressive manner, or on private property after being asked to leave or with a sign indicating solicitations are unwelcome.
112.03	Conducting a residential sale for more than two consecutive days or more than two separate sales within any calendar year.
112.04	Placing any items for sale at a residential sale too close to the property line.
112.05	Holding a residential sale without a permit.
130.01	Disturbing a public meeting, exhibition, or place of amusement.
130.02	Drinking an alcoholic beverage in public. Possession of an intoxicating beverage with the label visible in public.
130.20	Defacing any sign, advertisement, post, or billboard.
130.21	Writing or drawing obscene words on any public or private building without permission.
130.35	Possession of weapons on town-owned property.
130.36	Use of a bow and arrow or similar device within city limits.
130.37	Discharging firearms or air guns within city limits.
130.38	Hunting within city limits.
130.50	Loitering upon the premises or parking lot of any store, restaurant, theater, or shop after closing.
130.51	Loitering in the street between midnight and sunrise.
130.52	Loitering so as to interfere with the free passage of pedestrians on the sidewalk.
150.01	Beginning construction or alteration of a building without a permit.
150.29	Failure to comply with an order of the Inspector pursuant to this chapter.
150.51	Use or occupation of a condemned building.
