List of Ordinance Offenses Punishable as a Misdemeanor  
Session Law 2018-69  
As of November 29, 2018

TRAFFIC – Any person shall violate any provision of this code of ordinances, except any provision regulating the operation or parking of vehicles, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than \$500.

ANIMALS – Any owner of any dog who shall knowingly permit this dog to run at large after having been notified by a member of the Police Department or an Animal Control Officer that the dog was creating a nuisance as defined in 91.18(C) shall be in violation of 91.19 and shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable upon conviction not exceeding \$500 or imprisonment not exceeding 30 days.

HOUSING CODE – The violation of any provision of this chapter shall constitute a misdemeanor, punishable by fine of \$500.

NOISE CONTROL – A violation of the provisions of this chapter is a misdemeanor punishable in accordance with the provisions of G.S. 14.4. The fine for such violation shall not exceed \$500

SUBDIVISIONS – Any owner or agent of the owner of any land located within the territorial jurisdiction of this chapter who subdivides his land in violation of this chapter or transfers or sells land before the plat has been properly approved under the terms of this chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. And shall be subject, upon conviction to a fine of \$500 and/or imprisonment.

ZONING CODES – Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be punished for each offense by a fine not exceeding \$500 or by imprisonment not to exceed 30 days. Each day a violation continues shall be deemed a separate offense.
