CHAPTER 10 General Provisions

Sets forth the penalties for violating town ordinances.

10.99 General Penalty

CHAPTER 34 Fire Department

Prohibits (1) private use of fire equipment, (2) unauthorized entry of fire department, and (3) malicious false alarms.

34.05 Additional provisions; right-of-way rule; false alarms

CHAPTER 50 General Utilities

Prohibits occupancy of a dwelling without electric, water, or sewer service.

CHAPTER 51 Garbage Service

Requires disposal of various materials in compliance with the ordinance, including recyclables, and prohibits use and placement of waste containers and waste not in compliance with the requirements of the ordinance.

CHAPTER 91 Fire Protection and Prevention

Prohibits (1) congregation of persons or vehicles at scene of fire, (2) following of fire trucks responding to call, (3) damaging or interfering with fire equipment, (4) burning trash within municipal limits, (5) maintaining property creating a fire hazard, and (6) possession of storage tanks on certain properties.

CHAPTER 92 Health and Sanitation

Prohibits (1) privies; (2) not keeping property free of trash, waste, overgrown vegetation, or items generating stagnant water; (3) untimely removal of garbage or garbage cans; and (6) maintaining or creating other public nuisances.

CHAPTER 94 Streets and Sidewalks

Nuisances

Prohibits (1) damaging streets or sidewalks; (2) unpermitted construction impacting Town streets or sidewalks; (3) obstructing streets or sidewalks by assembly, construction, placement of objects or unauthorized vehicles, or display of goods; (4) throwing trash on streets; (5) and riding bicycles or skating on streets or sidewalks in certain areas.

Prohibits (1) conducting parades, picket lines, or demonstrations on public streets/sidewalks without a permit, (2) having a weapon or vicious dog while involved in such activity, and (3) interfering in such activities.

CHAPTER Nightclubs
