

CRIMINAL PENALTY LISTING

The following table sets forth code sections and uncodified ordinance provisions, if any, that specifically impose a criminal penalty under or derived from G.S. 14-4(a) authority. This listing excludes provisions imposing only civil fines, the civil fine portion of provisions imposing civil and criminal fines, and provisions imposing criminal fines derived from other, non-G.S. 14-4(a) related, statutory authority. (See the bottom of the final page for notes concerning the city's general penalty.) The list is in code chapter order with the exception of the Unified Development Ordinance (Chapter 12), which is placed at the end of the list due to its unique internal section numbering.

NOTES RE CITY'S GENERAL PENALTY AND RELATED STATUTES

City Code § 1-12 provides, in pertinent part: "Whenever in this Code or in any other ordinance of the city any act is prohibited or is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, or whenever in this Code or other ordinance the doing of any act is required or failure to do such act is declared to be unlawful and no other penalty is specified, a violation of such provision of this Code or other ordinance shall be punishable as a Class 3 misdemeanor and shall be fined no more than \$500.00; furthermore, no fine shall exceed \$50.00 unless the ordinance expressly states that the maximum fine is greater than \$50.00, as provided in G.S. § 14-4(a)."

- G.S. § 160A-175(b) provides: "Unless the Council shall otherwise provide, violation of a city ordinance is a misdemeanor or infraction as provided by G.S. 14-4. An ordinance may provide by express statement that the maximum fine, term of incarceration, or infraction penalty to be imposed for a violation is some amount of money or number of days less than the maximum imposed by G.S. 14-4."
- G.S. § 14-4(a) provides, in pertinent part: "Any person [who] shall violate an ordinance ... shall be guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than \$500.00. No fine shall exceed \$50.00 unless the ordinance expressly states that the maximum fine is greater than \$50.00."
- G.S. § 14-3 provides that the maximum punishment for a Class 3 misdemeanor is a fine of up to \$500.00 and incarceration of up to 30 days.
