Tax on Gross Receipts Derived from Short-Term Lease or Rental of Heavy Equipment	Chapter 117	Taxes relating to lease/rental of heavy equipment	Violators willfully evading payment are guilty of a Class H felony; violators failing to collect, withhold, account for or pay the tax are guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor; violators failing to pay tax, make returns, keep records or supply information are guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor Violators may be charged with a misdemeanor and be subject to a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or thirty (30) days in jail
