Chapter 130 General Offenses

Prohibits use of electric fences, discharging firearms within town limits, obstructing public ways, defacing or damaging town property, obstructing town property with signs or boxes, draining water from fish-bearing vehicles on town public ways, loitering for drug-related activity, and trespassing.

Offenses Against Public Peace and Safety
