

Chapter 10 General

Sets forth the penalties for violating town ordinances.

Prohibits violations of the Fire Prevention Code.

Chapter 40 Streets and Sidewalks

Prohibits (1) damaging streets or sidewalks; (2) unpermitted construction impacting Town streets or sidewalks; (3) obstructing streets or sidewalks by assembly, construction, placement of objects, or display of goods; (4) burning or throwing trash on streets; (5) and riding bicycles or playing baseball on streets or sidewalks.

Chapter 41 Garbage and Refuse Collection and Disposal

Requires disposal of various materials in compliance with the ordinance and prohibits use and placement of waste containers and waste not in compliance with the requirements of the ordinance.
