## TOWN OF SMITHFIELD LIST OF ORDINANCE OFFENSES PUNISHABLE AS A MISDEMEANOR SESSION LAW 2018-69

As of November 19, 2018

The Town Code of Smithfield under its General Provisions, Section 1-12 makes a violation of the code, a misdemeanor unless the specific section has an alternative punishment. The General Provisions state a violation shall be punishable as a misdemeanor, or in addition to or in lieu of, such civil penalties or other remedies, as amended, for each day the violation continues with a fine of up to five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and/or incarceration or other punishment as a class C misdemeanor. However, no fine (presumably civil) shall exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00) unless the specific ordinance (rather than this general provision) expressly states that the fine is greater than fifty dollars (\$50.00). Therefore, most Code sections create misdemeanors for violations. We summarize by referencing the Chapter of the Code followed by the activity thereby restricted.

- 4. Harboring, confining, hunting, abandoning and abusing animals.
- 5. Building inspections, permits, unsafe buildings and code violations.
- 6. Management of cemeteries and gravesites including maintenance, sale, opening and interment.
- 7. Fire Protection including restrictions on open fires, barbecues or interfering with fire fighters or access.
- 8. Disposition of trash as well as general yard maintenance including noxious weeds, grasses and yard trash.
- 9. Business franchise licenses as well as regulation of poolrooms, bowling alleys, yard sales, adult businesses and electronic gaming.
- 9.5 Minimum housing standards.
- 10. Traffic regulation including abandoned and junk vehicles.
- 11. Noise regulations, solicitation, festival conduct and drinking in public.
- 12. Use of town parks and parking therein.
- 13. Peddlers and solicitors traveling from place to place.
- 15. & 20. Zoning and use regulations including certificates of appropriateness supplemented by Appendix A, B, & C of the Code.
- 17. Use of streets, sidewalks and public places.
- 18. Use of and access to town utilities
- 19. Operation of vehicles for hire
- 20. Storm water management obligations and enforcement including inspection, maintenance, illegal discharge and connection, riparian buffers, and flood regulations.
