	Sec.4-3		Ord 32-09 Ord 01-18	Prohibiting no more than 6 dogs at any one time Control of Dogs/droppings Prohibiting domestic fowl, cow, sheep,hog,pig, swine, goat, horse, mule, or other livestockwithin corporate limits. Allowance of horses within town limits but not within 150 feet of a business or residence, exept the residence or business of the owner. Maintenance of the horse stable. Exemptions to prohibitions, and penalty.

Chapter 6	Sec. 6-19 thru 6-161	Building and Building Regulations	Ord 04-78	Condemnation, Repair, and Demolition of Unsafe Buildings - Order to remedy or demolish, Appeal, Compliance, Noice of hearing, presumption of danger to public, willful failure or refusal to comply with order. Requires application and obtaining a license to go house from house, selling or taking orders for the sale of goods, wares, merchandise, tangible or intangible personal property, etc; and operation of a business out of any motor vehicle, trailer, tents, rolling equipment, etc. intended to be temporary. Excemptions allowed, bonding, license fees, use of streets, loud noises, reportin of violations, revocation of license and reasons thereof, expiration of licenses, and penalty.

List prohibited acts or conditions
Chapter 10	Sec. 10-19	Noise -Unreasonably Loud Noise	Ord 04-79	Regulates excessive noise that creates a threat to public health, safety, and welfare. Determination of unreasonable noise from amplified devices emitting sound that is audible from a distance of 50' or more from the sound source, unless such device is being used to request assistance or warning against an unsafe condition. List exceptions to the provisions. violations and penalties.
	Sec. 10-42 thru 10-46	Sound Amplication	Ord 03-93	Regulates conditions, or any combination thereof, are hereby found, deemed, and declared to constitute a detriment, danger and hazard to health, safety, morals and general welfare of the inhabitants of the town and are found, deemed and declared to be public nuisances wherever the conditions may exist and the creation, maintenance or failure to abate any nuisances is hereby declared unlawful: overgrown vegetation , height restrictions; garbage, trash, junk, etc; abatement and notice of abatement; property owners failure to comply; procedures

				Shall be unlawful for any person to discharge a firearm at any time or place within the town except when used in defense of person or property. List exceptions. Unlawful consumption of alcohol/unfortified wine on any public road, street, highway, sidewalk, or parking area within the town, private parking lot or area, in a public building or private commercial establishment w/o permission of the owner.Unlawfully allowed possession and use of certain weapons by minors under 12 years of age (listing such weapons).

However, unfortified wine and/or beer may be allowed at "special events" held in Troutman ESC Park only upon permission and conditions of the town manager and town council for "Special Events"

	Sec. 22-1 thru 22-3	Property-Dep. Of materials in public ways	Ord 03-89	Unlawful obstruction of water flow, unlawful deposit of materials in public ways; in, over, along, upon, or through any gutte, drainage way, or ditch in any street or other public way in the town.
	Sec. 22-5	unhealthy matter in streets or sidewalks	Ord 11-09/36-09	Unlawful to throw or deposit injurious or unhealthy matter in the streets or sidewalks
	Sec. 22-90 thru 22-92	Use of Public Property	Ord 03-07	Unlawful for failure to leave public proterty within the Town when asked to leave; violate any rule or regulation pertaining to town property or facility (hr's and parking); littering, congregating, biking, skatinboarding, or skating of any kind; stafing, playing, etc.,as outlined in ordinance.
	Sec. 26-31 thru 26-41	Parking	Ord 20-18	Prohibited in certain places, prohibited for certain purposes, parking not to obstruct traffic, prohibited for certain purposes, no parking for the purpose of advertising, stand or parking on one-way rds, handicapped spaces, prohibited at all times in certain locations, misc. vehicles, municipal parking lot, penalties and enforcement.
Chapter 26	Sec. 26-100 thru 26-104	Truck Routes	Ord 09-86	Restriction the travel of trucks defined as any vehicle having dual rear tires on one axle. Declaration of truck routes, designation of truck routes, and unlawful operation of trucks.
