RE: Body-Worn Cameras Grant Report

DATE: August 1, 2019

Pursuant to North Carolina Session Law 2018-5, Sections 16.1 and 16.2, the Governor's Crime Commission shall report to the chairs of the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Justice and Public Safety on all grant awards made by the Commission from State funds during the prior fiscal year. The report shall contain all of the following information:

- (1) *The name of the unit of local government receiving the grant.*
- (2) *The purpose of the grant.*
- (3) *The economic tier of the county where the unit of local government receiving the grant is located.*
- (4) *Any recommended changes to State-funded grant programs to benefit local law enforcement agencies.*
